

RULES OF CHARGE FOR VASKI-BICYCLES

In general

The borrower has to accept the rules of charge for both Vaski-bicycles and Vaski-libraries. Bicycles are borrowed with the library card. In addition to the library card, the borrower needs an identification card (passport, driver's license, ID card), that is left at the library as a deposit until the bicycle is returned.

The bicycle is borrowed at the Main Library's reception. There are 7 bicycles and 1 electric bicycle to be borrowed.

Responsibility of the bicycle

The borrower is responsible of any personal injuries on self or others and damages on the bicycle. The borrower is obligated to pay for lost parts and the damage inflicted upon the bicycle during the loan period. The borrower is not obligated to compensate damage that is caused by normal usage, for example a blown tire.

The borrower has to check that the bicycle is in working order before it is taken into use. Both the Vaski-bicycle and the key are on the borrower's responsibility until they are appropriately returned. The bicycle is not to be left unlocked and unsupervised anywhere.

The borrower has to fully accept both the rules of charge for the bicycles and the Vaski-libraries. By borrowing a bicycle the borrower confirms that they have both read, understood, and accepted the rules of charge. Returning the bicycle

The borrower gets his identification card back when the bicycle is returned. Bicycles are returned at the Main Library entrance hall at the reception, at least one hour before closing.

The bicycle's overdue fine is 10 €/day and at most 70 € in total. Overdue notifications and billing fees are charged in the same manner as for any other library materials. In case of accidents the borrower is obliged to pay 280 € deductible for bicycles and 1 300 € deductible for the electric bicycle (the maximum amount applies to cases where the bicycle is beyond repair, stolen or not returned).

The bicycle key is not to be handed over to anyone else.
